1. 1. Who is the data controller?

2. What data do we process?

The data we process are identification and contact data, namely:

- Name and surname
- Company name
- Company email address or otherwise indicated in the contact documentation
- Business phone or otherwise indicated in the contact documentation

3. For what purposes do we process your data?

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- information on the activities inherent to the person's corporate role
- inclusion in the supplier database
- send requests for offers regarding suppliers
- send commercial proposals regarding customers

4. To whom can your data be communicated?

Your data may be communicated to:

- suppliers of IT, communication, assistance and consultancy services chosen by EXA
- competent public authorities, if requested

5. Can your data be transferred abroad?

Your data will not be transferred outside the company.

6.1 How long will your data be processed?

Your data will be kept for the entire duration of the company; if it ceases its activity and is dissolved, the data will be deleted.

6.2 What are your rights and how can you exercise them?

Anyone can exercise the right to:
